

Names of pubs and roadside/inns in the Hajdúnánás district

One of the basic tasks of Hungarian onomastics is to collect toponyms, but it is also important to analyse toponyms from a scientific point of view. In this article, I analyse the first printed book of the *Hungarian National Toponym Registry Programme*, looking at a particular type of toponyms: the names of pubs and inns. The book contains the toponyms of six settlements: *Folyás*, *Görbeháza*, *Hajdúnánás*, *Polgár*, *Tiszagyulaháza* and *Újtikos*. In these settlements, about 100 place names are used to designate pubs or inns. The article focuses on their semantic content.
