

Which verb should I use to hunt?

The paper presents the linguistic means used to express the complex act of hunting, fishing and gathering in Selkup. The basic verbs of this act, which are monolexemic, such as ‘hunt,’ ‘fish’ and ‘gather,’ are presented and analyzed. In addition, the object-focused verbs, which are formed by a special suffix and denote the act of hunting a particular animal or obtaining a plant, are also analyzed.
